- Promote the mission of Campus Pride and share widely resources, programs and services offered by Campus Pride.
- Encourage future participants of the Campus Pride Summer Leadership Camp.
- Share experiences, thoughts, and feelings with Campus Pride from conferences/events to possibly be posted online.
- Recruit students to become involved with the Campus Q Team.
- Participate in Monthly Regional Ambassador Conference Calls.
